

Travelling to County Hall, Worcester

Where possible visitors are encouraged to use public transport or to car share.

By Road from the M5 (See map below)

If travelling northwards on the M5 leave at junction 7 and take the first turning left from the large roundabout, signposted Worcester.

If travelling southwards on the M5 leave at junction 7 and take the third turning left from the large roundabout, signposted Worcester.

Travelling along the dual carriageway from the motorway roundabout go straight on at the next roundabout and again straight on at the second roundabout.

As you climb slight gradient move out to outside lane in preparation for a right turn at the next roundabout (the inside lane is not affected by roundabout). At the roundabout turn right into Spetchley Road.

Travel along Spetchley Road for approximately 1/3 of a mile. At the mini roundabout turn left into the County Hall Campus.

By Road from Worcester City Centre

Take the London Road away from the centre signposted M5 motorway and Evesham.

Travelling eastwards along London Road, passing through a set of traffic lights at the bottom of the first large hill, climb to the top of the next hill. Approach the large roundabout and take the first left (almost straight ahead if you remain in the inside lane) into Spetchley Road.

Travel along Spetchley Road for approximately 1/3 of a mile. At the mini roundabout turn left into the County Hall Campus.

Parking at County Hall

The car parks on the County Hall Campus are individually numbered for ease of identification. The following is a list of the car parks available for public use:

Car Park No. 3 – Visitor Parking

This car park is solely for use by visitors and is located to the south of the Record Office.

Car Park No. 6 – Disabled Parking

Located on the hard standing near the front entrance to County Hall.

Car Park No. 7 East (only) – Staff/Countryside Visitor Overspill Parking

Located adjacent to the Country Park car park.

Please note: Access control of the site and car parks at County Hall is maintained by barrier systems. There are two forms of barrier control:

Blockers (Sunk into the road) - These are in place to control through traffic across the campus between Spetchley Road and Wildwood Drive. The blockers allow access onto the site but restrict access off – a token from Reception is required for exit.

Arm barriers - An arm barrier system is in place for the Visitor car parking area. This does not restrict entry but, like the blockers, restricts access out of the car parks. The barrier on the Visitor Car Park allows exit with a token only. Exit requires a token issued by Reception.

By Bus


Bus service 44 runs between CrownGate Bus Station (3 minutes walk from Foregate Street railway station) and County Hall.

For timetable enquiries please call the County bus line on 0870 608 2608, local call rate applies.

Passengers arriving at Foregate Street railway station have no direct service to County Hall and are advised to travel to the CrownGate bus station and use the service 44.




County Hall Location Plan Not to Scale
