



Mutant Thoughts




Biography

Mutant-Thoughts is an Experimental Alternative band with Electronic and Rock influences, formed by Han Luis Cera (Vocals and Synths), Joshua Lennox-Hilton (Bass and Backing Vocals) and Tom Pearmain (Drums), with an eclectic, eerie vibe as well as beautiful melodies.

Mutant-Thoughts' live show is very energetic, full of groovy odd time signatures, crazy synth sounds, heavy bass lines, nice vocal harmonies, and no guitars. With a very strong rhythm section, and the use of interesting soundscapes and experimentation, the band is able to create very contrasting vibes, and transform our surroundings into a completely new reality which is perceived with detail in the music.

Mutant-Thoughts' debut Album, "Humans" (2016), is an electronic adaptation of the songs Mutant-Thoughts play live. It is a 9 songs album, in which they started to explore their unique sound. In 2017 they released Is This Me? as the first studio EP, with 4 songs and 2 poems accompanied by soundscapes that glue together a new exploration of their sound.

All of a sudden, the Exchange is a skank-fest with two-stepping the name of the game and it's a buoyant mood that greets next act **Mutant Thoughts**, who proceed to space the entire venue out with a mixture of experimental and avant-garde rock that lends as much as it does to Pink Floyd as it does to Faith No More and Caspian. The underlying tones register as a somber note which creates an oppressive atmosphere at the core of the material, which is equally matched by the funereal procession speed of the music overlaid with an equally subdued vocal. Slightly experimental in nature, without heading away from recognizable sounds of directions of travel **Mutant-Thoughts** create a powerful imagery and emotional drive within the listener.

The music weaves a path into the mind of the audience taking them on a journey of discovery, which despite it's inherent sadness somehow feels comforting, allowing the head to wallow in thoughts of personal misfortune without becoming introspectively indulgent.
